

LANDSCAPE OF CLIMATE FINANCE IN 2019/2020


Global Landscape of Climate Finance



Objective

Develop a vision for the project and set a clear purpose, in context of stakeholder engagement. Identify elements of the national climate finance mapping framework.

Identify data sources and fill potential gaps. Understand options for data consolidation, data analyzing and how to present and interpret results and inform policy or project processes.



Landscape of Climate Finance in Kenya 2018 – USD 2.4 billion


OUTCOMES/IMPACT

- Developed Kenya's first step towards enhancing transparency of the climate finance support needed and received through international and national sources.
- Conducted Kenya's first budget tagging exercise as part of the study
- Helped in develop a financing roadmap for Kenya's NDC implementation (GNIplus initiative)





Overview of key data providers of climate finance in Kenya






Landscape of Climate Finance in South Africa 2023

- Tracking alignment of report taxonomy with South African Green Finance Taxonomy, so that report can be the most useful to public stake holders.


