Approach for the development of the AWP-2023

- **Development of the Work Plan for 2023 for Central Asia and the Caucasus** is based on:
 - Key findings and priorities determined in the rapid assessment for transparency
 - Bilateral online meetings with country representatives
 - Online meetings with international transparency partners (still ongoing)
 - Desk-top study (UNDP and UNEP, CAREC/ICAT assessments, NCs and BURs, NDCs)
- The Work Plan is a **live document** with the possibility to merge the events with other networks and synchronize with activities of other partners
- **All dates** for the events **are tentative** and dependent on the resources
- **The Work Plan** envisages only those **activities** which are planned **for 2023**
- Additional activities might be added based on ad-hoc requests from countries
- Possibilities to use **Russian or English-Russian language** mode of communication/delivery
