

- National Advisory Board (NAB) on CC&DRR
- Within Government Request for specific data
- Request for Data to the Private entities once needed (for its purposes only)
- Memorandum of Understanding (Data Sharing)
- Domestic MRV system (NDC tracking), MRV NFI & Forest Change



CHALLENGES ON DATA USE & SHARING

- Outdated data from some institutions
- Sharing data may be a issue for many (Business integrity)
- Lack of institutional and Human resource capacity within data institutions in collecting and updating data

WAY FORWARDS ADDRESSING CHALLENGES

- Formalize data sharing within different data institutions and the Department of Climate Change through MOU/MOA
- CBIT project will support addressing this gaps ((Establishment of the National ETF body, MOU, Amend MRV tools to incorporate latest decisions on reporting, data archiving templates + others)
- Working on resourcing the different departments within their structures to have data officer or embedded as part of the relevant Job Description (JD) – Data collection and sharing
