

Climate Transparency Platform

Objective of the Climate Transparency Platform

Provide countries and support providers with a one-stop knowledge clearing house on climate transparency

1 - Transparency project information

Ongoing and upcoming in-country, regional and global initiatives through a project database.

3 - Transparency resources

A library of practices, methodologies and guidance, including Paris Rulebook and CGE.

5 - Platform for requesting support

A platform and forum for requesting assistance with country reports and transparency issues



2 - Transparency country information

Profiles with information on progress on NCs and BURs, self-assessed needs, and CBIT projects.

4 - Interactive userdriven forum

Information exchange and online tools for peer learning, coordination for regional MRV and transparency networks.



Stakeholder Consultations for the Platform

During Q2 2022, 5 consultations held with transparency experts, country & project focal points, and international agencies & initiatives


Objective:

- Communities of Practice place (still under development) for all registered users as a dynamic hub for thematic discussions, knowledge sharing, and important announcements
- Planning tool for support providers on upcoming trainings, events and knowledge products
- Country profiles with list of all transparency projects






User Role: Nominated Country Focal Points under the CBIT-GSP

Nominated Focal Points under the **CBIT-GSP:**


- General CBIT-GSP Project Focal Point, called "Country Focal Point"

 - Support








