Objective

Support country teams enhance the technical understanding of the reporting process for NDC mitigation commitments and associated requirements:

- Provide national mitigation teams with useful information and experiences to facilitate their reporting, including:
 - Preparing for the use of the common tabular formats
 - The use of modeling tools for determining scenarios and projections and how they can be used for tracking NDCs
 - The use of select NDC tracking tools
- Get a kick start in tracking NDCs using real country data and their own NDC
- Exchange experiences and lessons learned, corresponding to the application of tools and systems for mitigation assessment, tracking and reporting
- Identify common challenges and opportunities for collaboration among country teams on mitigation assessment, tracking and reporting

Four Stages Approach



Stage 1: Introductory Webinar

Objective

- Introduce the training and the main concepts and provisions for NDC tracking
- Provide instructions and tools to the participants for the preparation of the next stages of the training

Content

- Introduction to ETF reporting requirements
- Introduction to mitigation tracking in the context of UNFCCC, data compilation, UNFCCC templates. existing tools for BTR preparation, indicators and projections.
- Practical case on NDC tracking
- Guidance for following stages: Data needs for following stages II and III of the Workshop. Presentation of templates to be filled as a part of the workshop

Stage 2: In-Country Data Collection

Objective

- Gather the necessary data for use during the in-person training and get familiarized with own NDC

Content

- Familiarization with own NDC
- Data gathering
- Filling the provided templates



Critical stage for the success of the in-person training

Stage 3: In-Person Training

Objective

- Equip the participants with knowledge and tools necessary for tracking the mitigation component of their NDC using their own data and identify solutions and tools to use when data are not available

Content

- Theme of Day 1: ETF, Mitigation in NDCs and Indicators
- Theme of Day 2: Training on filling in the Common Tabular Formats
- Theme of Day 3: Tracking and reporting using various tools

Stage 4: Follow-up

Objective

- Consolidation of the learning from the training and opportunity to progress with the tracking

Content

- Follow-up with the participants and review of the results of homework
- Select some pilot cases for further support from the CBIT-GSP
