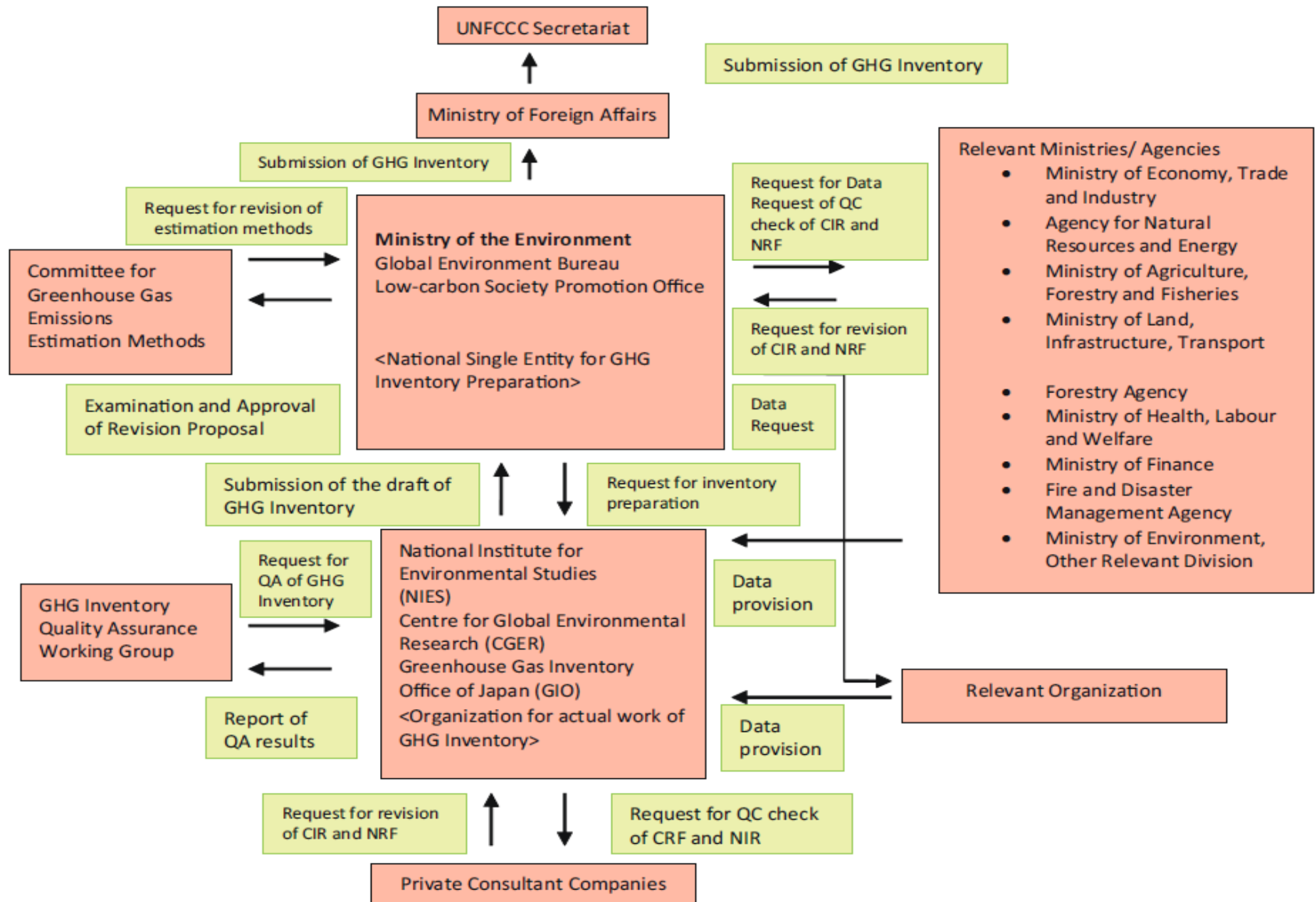


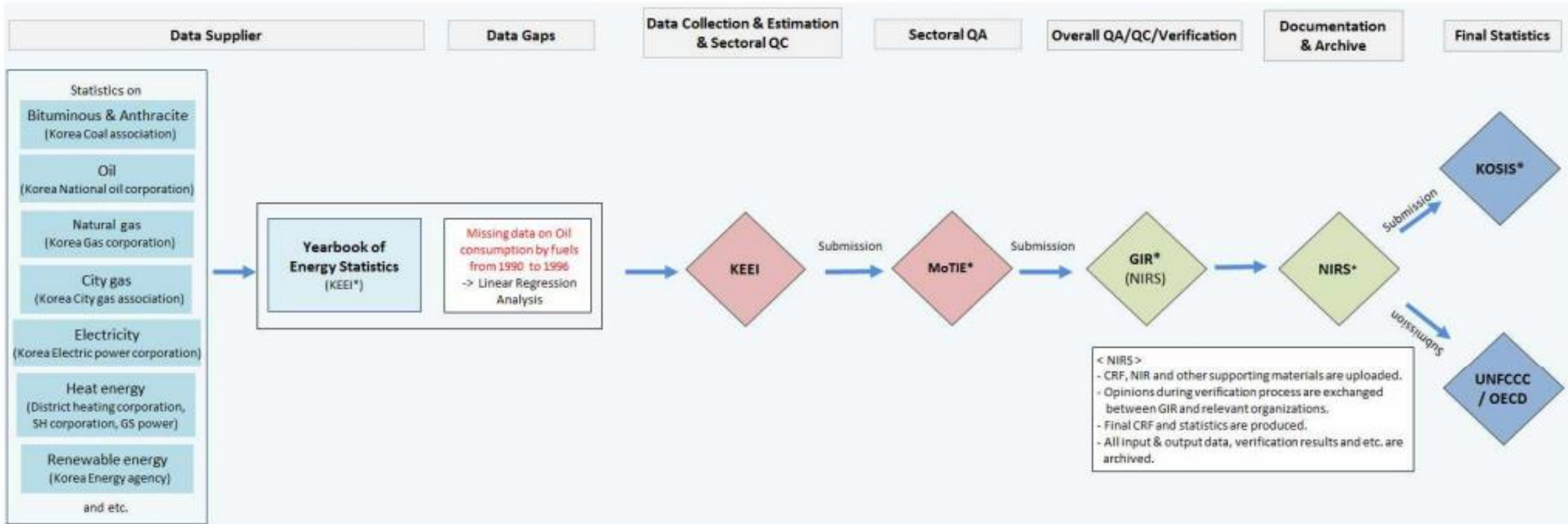


India National GHG Inventory Cycle

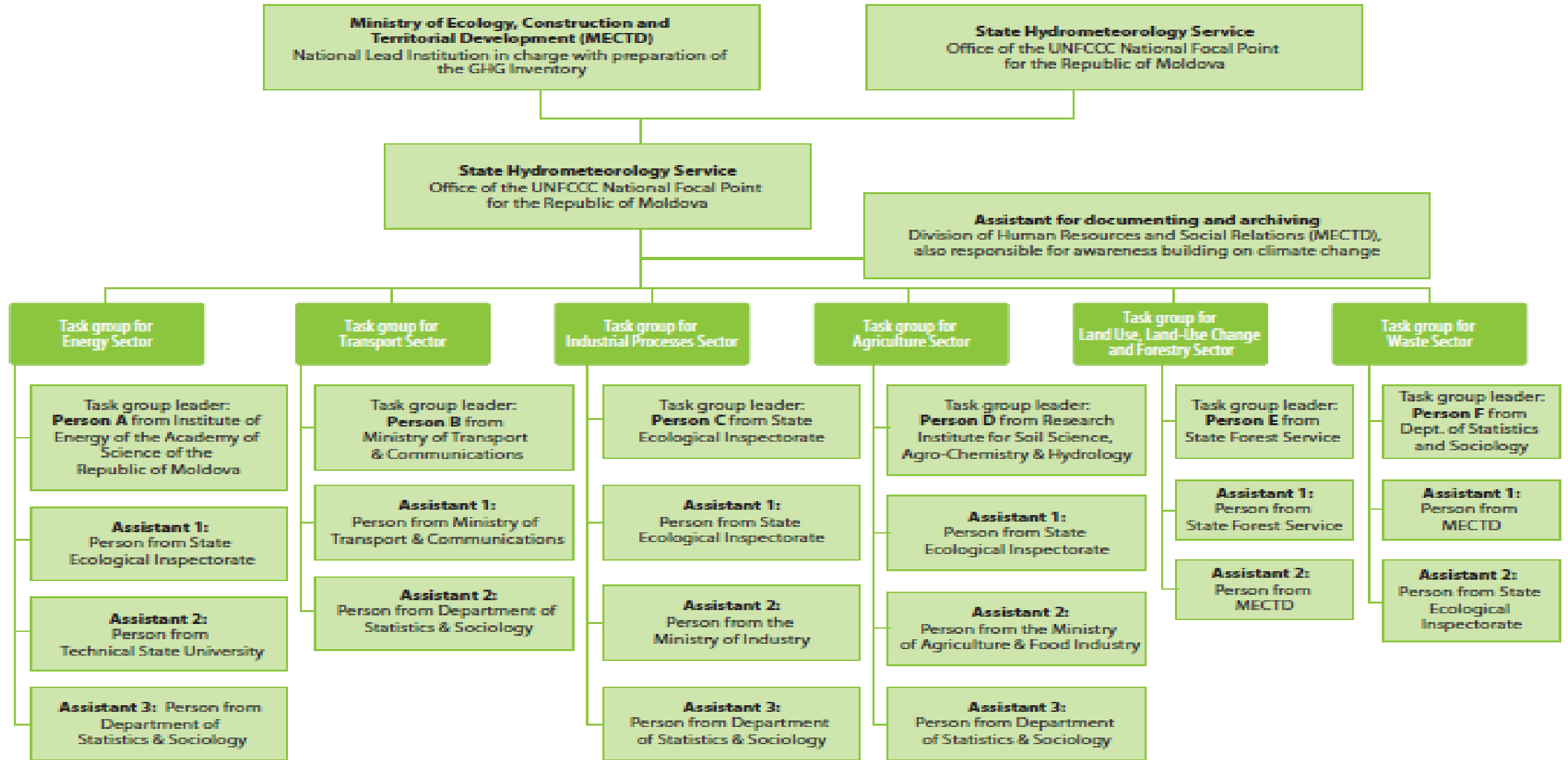
