Objective of the Climate Transparency Platform

Provide countries and support providers with a one-stop shop for transparency on climate transparency

1 - Transparency project information

Ongoing and upcoming in-country, regional and global initiatives through a project database.

3 - Transparency resources

A library of practices, methodologies and guidance, including Paris Rulebook and CGE.

5 - Platform for requesting support

A platform and forum for requesting assistance with country reports and transparency issues



2 - Transparency country information

Profiles with information on progress on NCs and BURs, selfassessed needs, and CBIT projects.

4 - Interactive userdriven forum

Information exchange and online tools for peer learning, coordination for regional MRV and transparency networks.

- Shared responsibility among all to keep it updated and useful for everyone




User Role - Country Focal Points

 - Loss & Damage








Country Focal Points

Keeping the Country Profile up to date → Regular updates (monthly) and/or whenever relevant:

- New Climate Transparency Reports (e.g., BTR, NC)
- New or updated Climate Documents to the UNFCCC (NDC, NAP, LT-LEDS)
- New other relevant climate documents (e.g., Adaptation Strategy)
- Change of Country Focal Points
- Country News & Events (e.g., launch of a CBIT project, publication of an LT-LEDS, event at COP or Climate weeks)
- Opportunities (e.g., Vacancy for a CBIT Project Manager)

Project Focal Points


Keeping the Project page up to date → Regular updates (monthly) and/or whenever relevant:
