Ongoing and upcoming in-country, regional and global initiatives through a project database.

## 3 - Transparency resources

A library of practices, methodologies and guidance, including Paris Rulebook and CGE.

## 5 - Platform for requesting support

A platform and forum for requesting assistance with country reports and transparency issues



## 2 - Transparency country information

Profiles with information on progress on NCs and BURs, self-assessed needs, and CBIT projects.

## 4 - Interactive user-driven forum

Information exchange and online tools for peer learning, coordination for regional MRV and transparency networks.

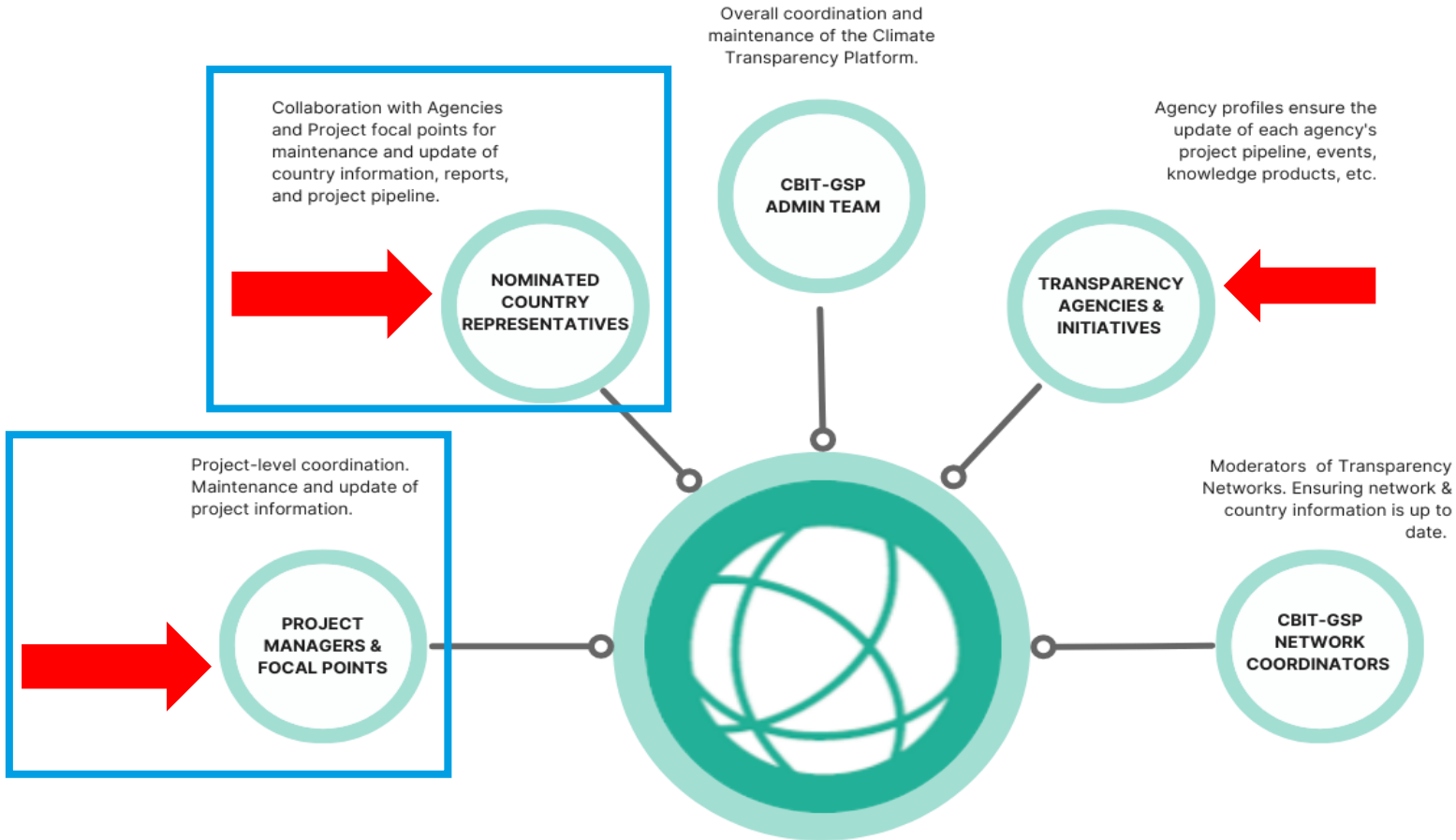
