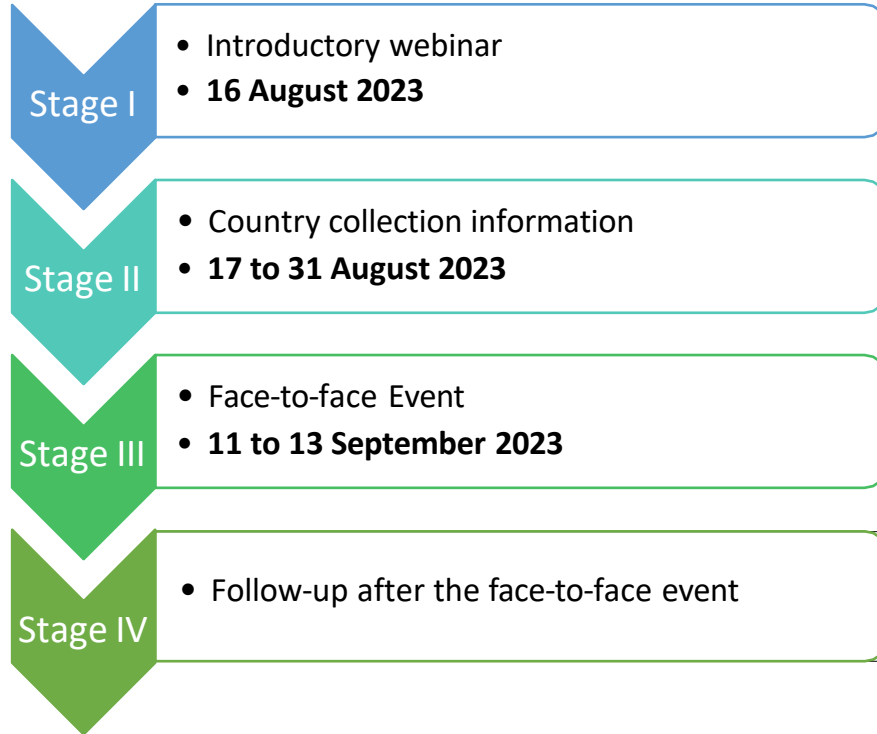
Objective
