Approach for the development of the AWP 2024

- **Development** of the **Work Plan for 2024 for Asia** is based on:
 - Bilateral online meetings with country representatives
 - Online meetings with international transparency partners (still ongoing)
 - Desk-top study (UNDP and UNEP, NCs and BURs, NDCs)
- The Work Plan is a **live document** with the possibility to merge the events with other networks and synchronize with activities of other partners
- **All dates** for the events **are tentative** and dependent on the resources
- **The Work Plan** envisages only those **activities** which are planned **for 2024**
- Additional activities might be added based on ad-hoc requests from countries

Key points of the AWP 2024

- Intention to organize the **Global Transparency Forum** which will take place in the second quarter, during which CBIT GSP focal points will be invited to discuss the preparation of BTR and the implementation of ETF in their countries.
- The **GHG Inventory** is a **key theme** for 2024, with a majority of the webinars, workshops, and hands-on support dedicated to this subject.
- A series of webinars will be conducted to provide a comprehensive understanding of **adaptation reporting** in BTR.
- Organize a **Mutual learning sessions** which specifically address topics such as Data management, NDC tracking, Article 6, and QA/QC plans.
- Analyzing **MPGs Paragraphs** and **Flexibility Provisions** with focus to GHG Inventory and NDC Tracking sections.
- Considering 2024 as BTR submission year, greater emphasis given to **country support activities**.
