



#### ETF vis-à-vis existing MRV arrangements





#### Key areas of enhancement

- Establishes common modalities, procedures and guidelines (MPGs) applicable to all Parties with flexibility to those developing countries that need it in the light of their capacities
- Parties need to (to the extent possible) identify, regularly update, and report on areas of improvement > continuous improvement
- Provisions/requirements mostly mandatory ("shall")
- NDCs, reporting, TER and FMCP, and their relationship to the Article 15 Committee (mechanism to facilitate implementation of and promote compliance)

# TRANSITIONING FROM THE EXISTING MRV ARRANGEMENTS

- Final blennial reports submitted by developed country Parties no later than 31 December 2022
- Final blennial update reports submitted by developing country Parties no later than 31 December 2024
- National Communications reporting remains the same


#### BIENNIAL TRANSPARENCY REPORTS (BTRs)

 First BTRs [and national inventory report, if it is a stand-alone report] submitted at the latest by 31 December 2024

BTRs include the following information:

- National Inventory report on GHGs ("shall")
- Information on tracking progress of implementation and achievement of NDCs ("shall")
- Information on climate change impacts and adaptation ("should")
- Information on support provided ("developed countries shall`")
- Information on support needed and received ("developing countries should ")
- REDD+ activities as a technical annex ("may")

\*The LDCs and SIOS may submit the information at their discretion.



#### TECHNICAL EXPERT REVIEW (TER)

A team of technical experts will review the Party's national GHG inventory, information on tracking progress the Party makes in implementing and achieving its NDCs, and information on support provided to developing country Parties. Information submitted by other Parties that provide support may undergo a TER at the Party's discretion.

The TER is carried out in a facilitative, non-intrusive and non-punitive manner, paying close attention to each developing country's national capabilities and circumstances. Following the review, the TER team will publish its report.

#### REPROPERTY FACILITATIVE MULTILATERAL CONSIDERATION OF PROGRESS (FMCP)

The FMCP is undertaken with respect to a Party's efforts under Article 9 of the Paris Agreement and the Party's respective implementation and achievements of its NDC. It will consider the BTR, the TER report and other information provided by the Party. It takes place following the publication of the TER report and is conducted in two phases:

- A written question and answer phase
- A working group session held during the sessions of the SBI

If the TER report is not available within 12 months, the opportunity to participate in the FMCP will still be arranged by the secretariat.

The BTR is submitted every two years. During this process, there is opportunity for Parties to continue to build capacity, gain support, gather data and continuously improve their reporting and transparency over time.

Flexibility Areas of improvement

#### **Built-in flexibility**



Flexibility provisions: available to developing country Parties that need it, in the light of their capacities.

Specified for individual provisions

Self-determined

Capacity constraints and time frames for improvements

TER team shall take into account the flexibility

TER teams shall not review the determination to apply such flexibility








#### FLEXIBILITY PROVISIONS TO PROMOTE UNIVERSAL PARTICIPATION

- The ETF will be implemented based on the MPGs that apply to all Parties.
- The MPGs recognize the special circumstances of LDCs and SIDS. It also recognizes the capacity constraints of developing country Parties and provide flexibility to those that need it in light of their capacities.





The flexibility provisions address the scope, frequency and level of detail of reporting, and the scope of review.



The application of flexibility provisions is decided by each developing country Party.





CLEARLY STATE THE REPORTING REQUIREMENT TO WHICH THEY ARE CHOOSING TO APPLY FLEXIBILITY.



CLEARLY OUTLINE THEIR CAPACITY CONSTRAINTS, NOTING THAT SOME CONSTRAINTS MAY BE RELEVANT TO SEVERAL FLEXIBILITY PROVISIONS.



SELF-DETERMINE AND PROVIDE ESTIMATED TIME FRAMES FOR IMPROVEMENTS THAT RELATE TO THEIR CAPACITY CONSTRAINTS.



MPGs encourages/catalyzes universal participation by offering built-in flexibility, supporting ways to continuously improve and encouraging strong institutional arrangements.






# **Electronic Reporting Tools**




