- 83 individual country projects
- 1 regional project
- 5 global projects, including CBIT-GSP

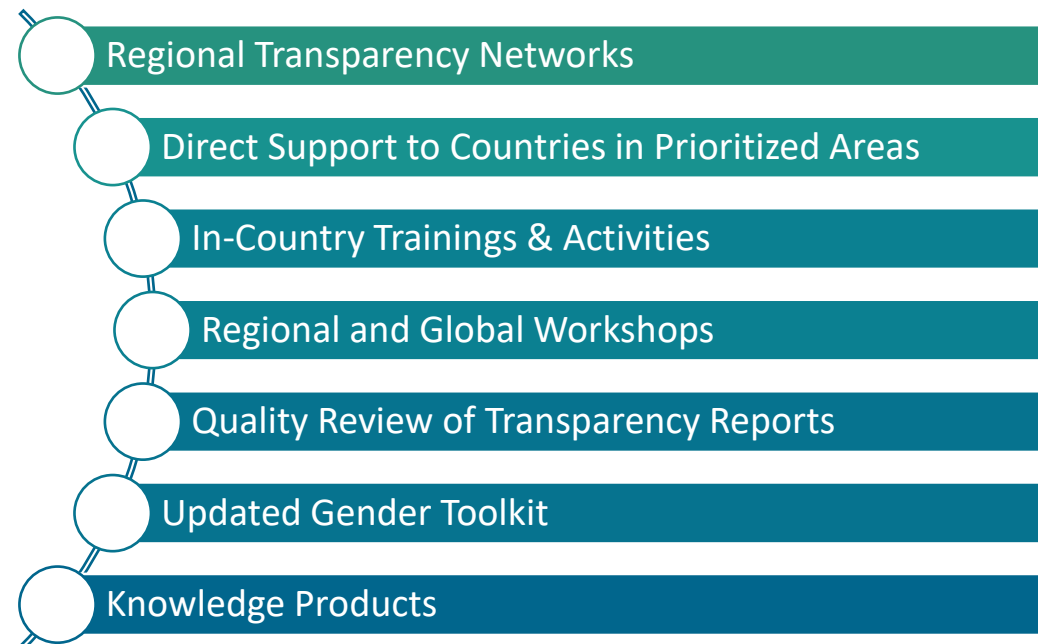
Project Information

- Duration: April 2022 – end of 2026, Budget: ~ 9 Million USD

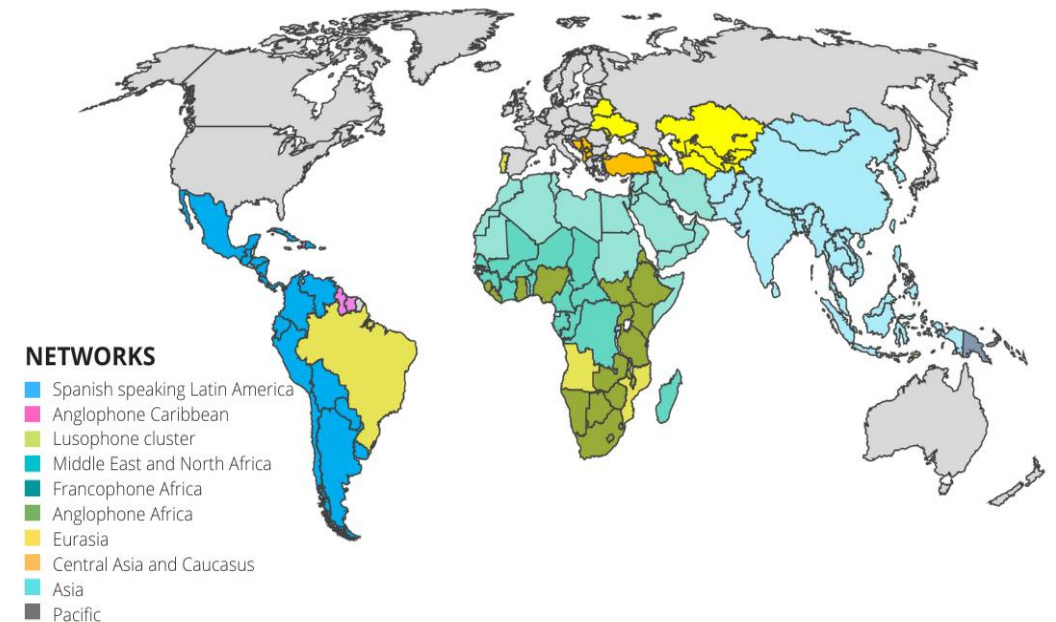
Objective
