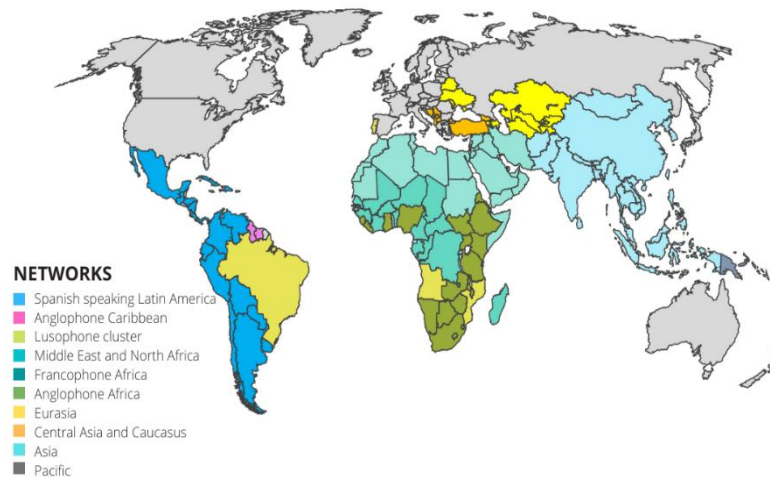
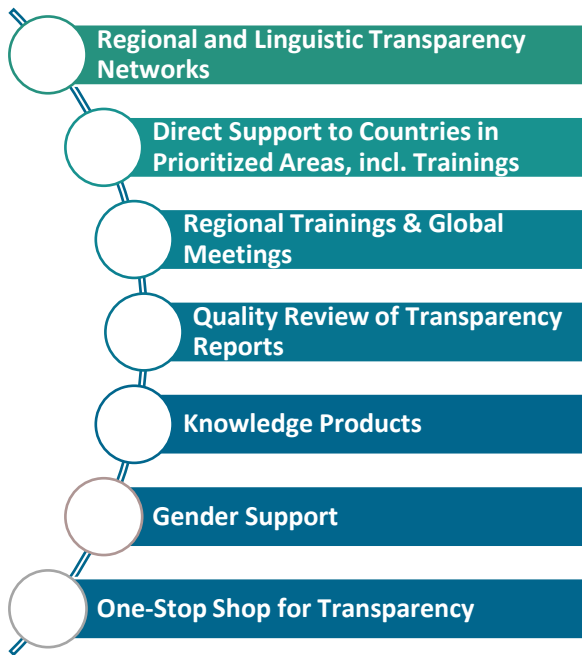

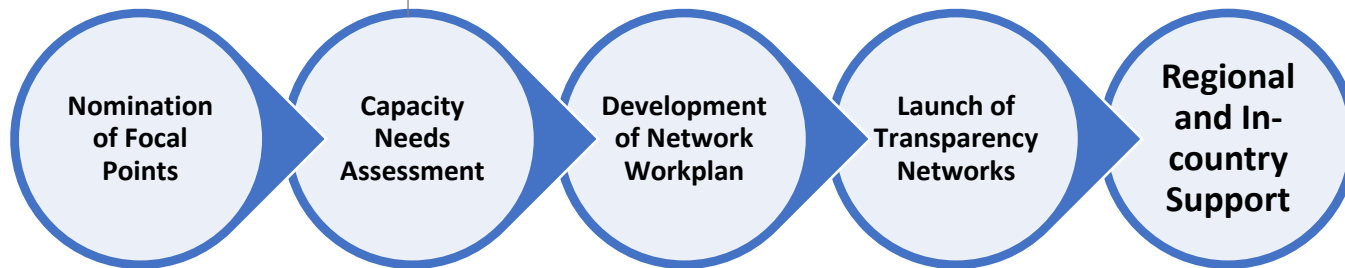

- Countries nominated Focal Points for the project and the different ETF areas (e.g.

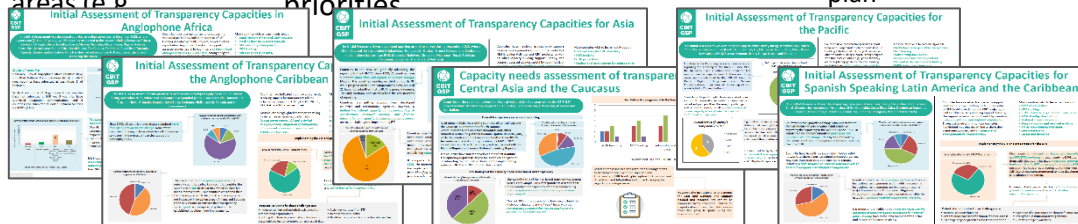
- Comprehensive survey with all countries to determine their needs and priorities
