Vietnam has submitted three National Communications (NCs) and three Biennial Update Reports (BURs) to the UNFCCC. Vietnam is also one of the few countries who submitted a National Inventory report in 2021. The country is now making rapid progress towards implementing the ETF and developing its first Biennial Transparency Report (BTR). The country is seeking to develop the capacity of its participants to create a comprehensive national inventory document that adheres to IPCC and UNFCCC standards. The hands-on training on the common reporting table will ensure efficient and accurate reporting of inventory data. The country recognizes the need to equip its participants with a deeper understanding of the principles, methodologies, and reporting requirements outlined in the 2006 IPCC Guidelines across all five sectors. This will enable them to accurately measure and report greenhouse gas emissions within their national context. By organizing an in-country workshop, the country can facilitate the exchange of experiences and lessons learned among its own stakeholders, including government officials, industry representatives,









and experts. This collaborative approach will help identify and address challenges in implementing sustainable practices within the national context. The workshop allows the country to tailor the training content and delivery to its specific needs and circumstances. This ensures the relevance and applicability of the knowledge and skills gained by the participants, ultimately supporting the country's efforts towards accurate greenhouse gas measurement and reporting for ETF of the Paris Agreement.
