## Parties to the Paris Agreement:


- Submit 1<sup>st</sup> BTR no later than 31 Dec 2024
- BTR to be submitted biennially and can include NIR as a component

## Core elements to be reported in the BTR of developing countries:

- National GHG inventory
- Information necessary to track progress made in implementing and achieving NDC under article 4 of the Paris Agreement
- Information on climate change impacts and adaptation
- Information on support needed and received by developing country Parties








## **National GHG inventory**

- NIR of anthropogenic GHG emissions by sources and removals by sinks
- NIR comprises of National Inventory Document and CRTs of electronic reporting of info in the MPGs



- Adaptation info is reported on a voluntary basis
  - Whether to report it
  - Type of info to report
- Parties can choose to cross reference previously reported adaptation info
- Update information previously reported
