Objective and description

Under the Paris Agreement, Parties are obligated to submit their first Biennial Transparency Report (BTR1) and, if applicable, a stand-alone national inventory report. These submissions must adhere to the Modalities, Procedures, and Guidelines (MPGs) outlined in decision 18/CMA.1, with a deadline set for no later than 31 December 2024. Following decision 5/CMA.3, the UNFCCC secretariat has been tasked with creating electronic tools for reporting through common reporting tables and formats, ensuring a test version of these tools is available by June 2023, and releasing the final version by June 2024.

Additionally, the secretariat is to organize periodic technical training workshops, offering a hands-on experience with the reporting tools to experts from the Parties. The upcoming hands-on training workshop will be a collaborative effort involving the UNFCCC, the CBIT GSP, and the Republic of Moldova's Ministry of Environment.
