

# Introduction to BTR Outline

**Parties to the Paris Agreement:** 


- Submit 1<sup>st</sup> BTR no later than 31 Dec 2024
- BTR to be submitted biennially and can include NIR as a component

Core elements to be reported in the BTR of developing countries:

- **National GHG inventory**
- Information necessary to track progress made in implementing and achieving NDC under article 4 of the Paris Agreement
- Information on climate change impacts and adaptation
- Information on support needed and received by developing country **Parties**







**National GHG inventory** 

- NIR of anthropogenic GHG emissions by sources and removals by sinks
- NIR comprises of National Inventory Document and CRTs of electronic reporting of info in the MPGs




Information related to climate change impacts and adaptation






