

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

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


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Thematic focus of trainings attended



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

Contribution to improving and strengthening MRV/transparency activities










Way(s) in which trainings improved and/or strengthened countries' MRV/transparency activities




Overall satisfaction with the training(s) over the course of 2024

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






Have you applied the knowledge and skills gained during trainings or other guidance in preparation of national reporting documents such as BTRs, NIDs, NCs, etc.,.?



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

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




BTR status and challenges for timely submissions

1. Türkiye: submitted


- 2. Georgia, Moldova, Montenegro and Serbia-by Dec.31
- 3. Remaining countries- by mid of 2025




- Institutional and organizational difficulties,
