









### **Gender Participation in 2024**

CBIT-GSP CLIMATE TRANSPARENCY



- Asia Region
- 86 Participants
- Attendance
  - Online training dominated (79.1%)
  - In-country training was significant (36%)
  - Regional training had lower participation (16.3%)

#### Top tier focus areas:

- GHG inventory (53.5%)
- Climate adaptation (40.7%)
- Climate transparency (40.7%)

#### Middle tier focus areas:

- NDC tracking (26.7%)
- Climate mitigation (25.6%)

#### Lower tier focus areas:


- Data collection and management (15.1%)





Overall, how satisfied are you with the training(s) you have received over the course of 2024?


