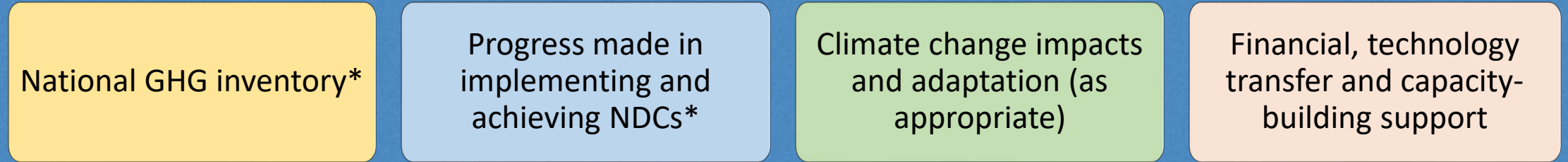
Paris Agreement goals

- Mitigation**
keep temperature increase to well below +2/1.5 degree C
- Adaptation**
increase the ability to adapt and foster resilience
- Financial flows**
consistent with path to low GHG emissions and resilient development

Clarity on impacts and how adaptation actions are contributing to



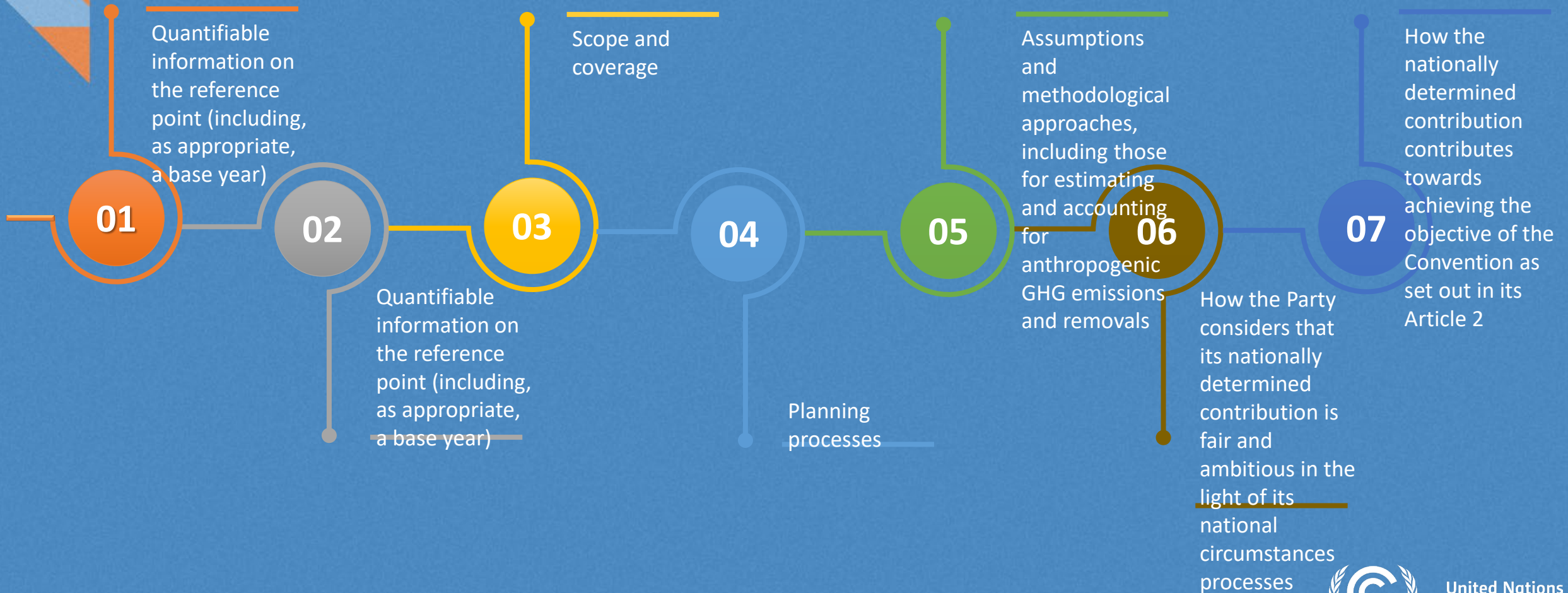
Clarity on what and how international support is flowing, and how they are addressing the needs

Information to facilitate clarity, transparency and understanding of nationally determined contributions



Accounting for Parties' nationally determined contributions

01

Accounting for anthropogenic emissions and removals in accordance with methodologies and common metrics assessed by the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) and adopted by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement

02

Ensuring methodological consistency, including on baselines, between the communication and implementation of nationally determined contributions

03

Striving to include all categories of anthropogenic emissions or removals in the nationally determined contribution and, once a source, sink or activity is included, continuing to include it

04

Providing an explanation of why any categories of anthropogenic emissions or removals are excluded



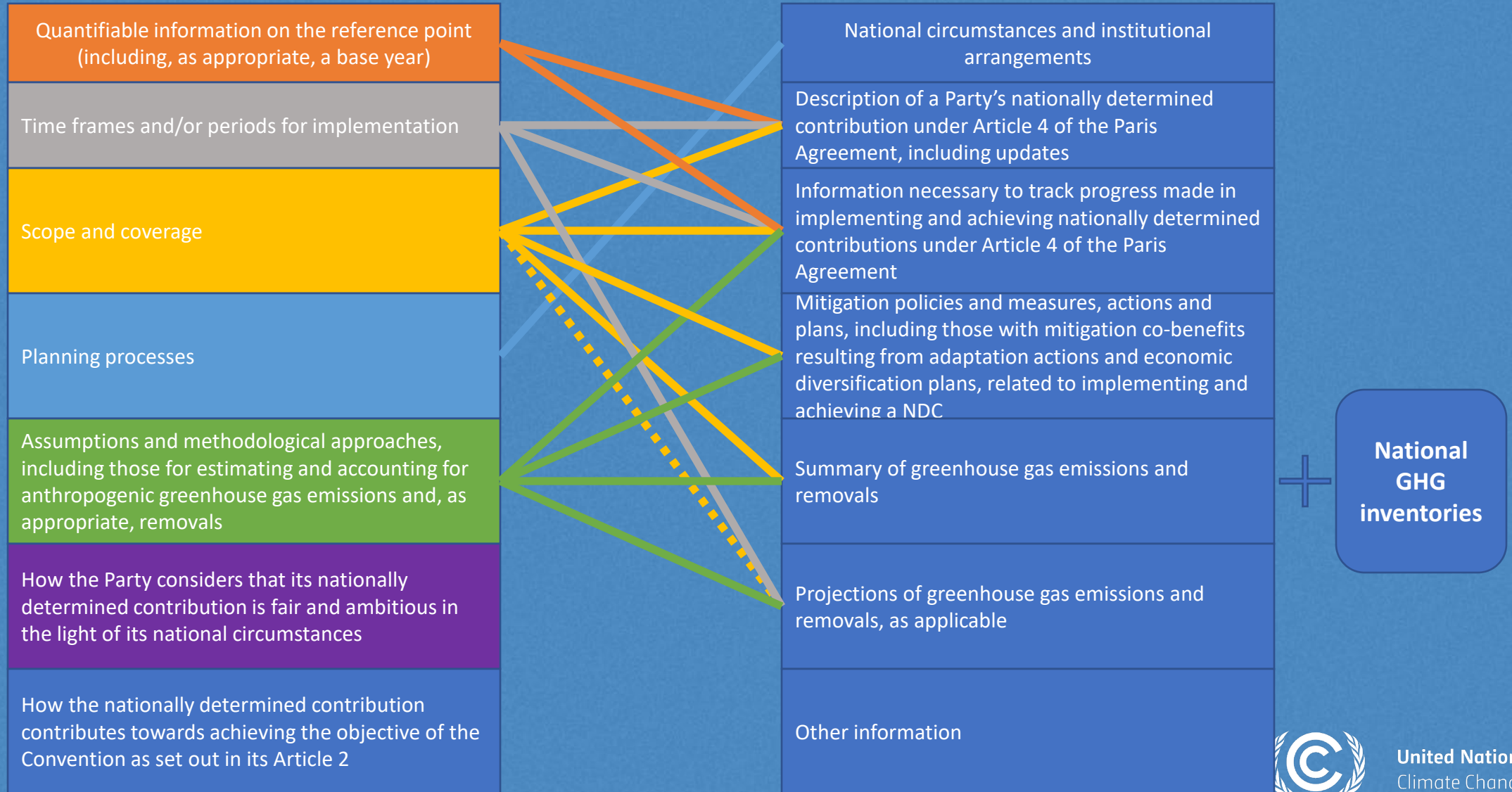
Modalities, procedures and guidelines for tracking progress of implementation and achievement of NDCs

- A. National circumstances and institutional arrangements
- B. Description of a Party's nationally determined contribution under Article 4 of the Paris Agreement, including updates
- C. Information necessary to track progress made in implementing and achieving nationally determined contributions under Article 4 of the Paris Agreement
- D. Mitigation policies and measures, actions and plans, including those with mitigation co-benefits resulting from adaptation actions and economic diversification plans, related to implementing and achieving a nationally determined contribution under Article 4 of the Paris Agreement
- E. Summary of greenhouse gas emissions and removals
- F. Projections of greenhouse gas emissions and removals, as applicable
- G. Other information

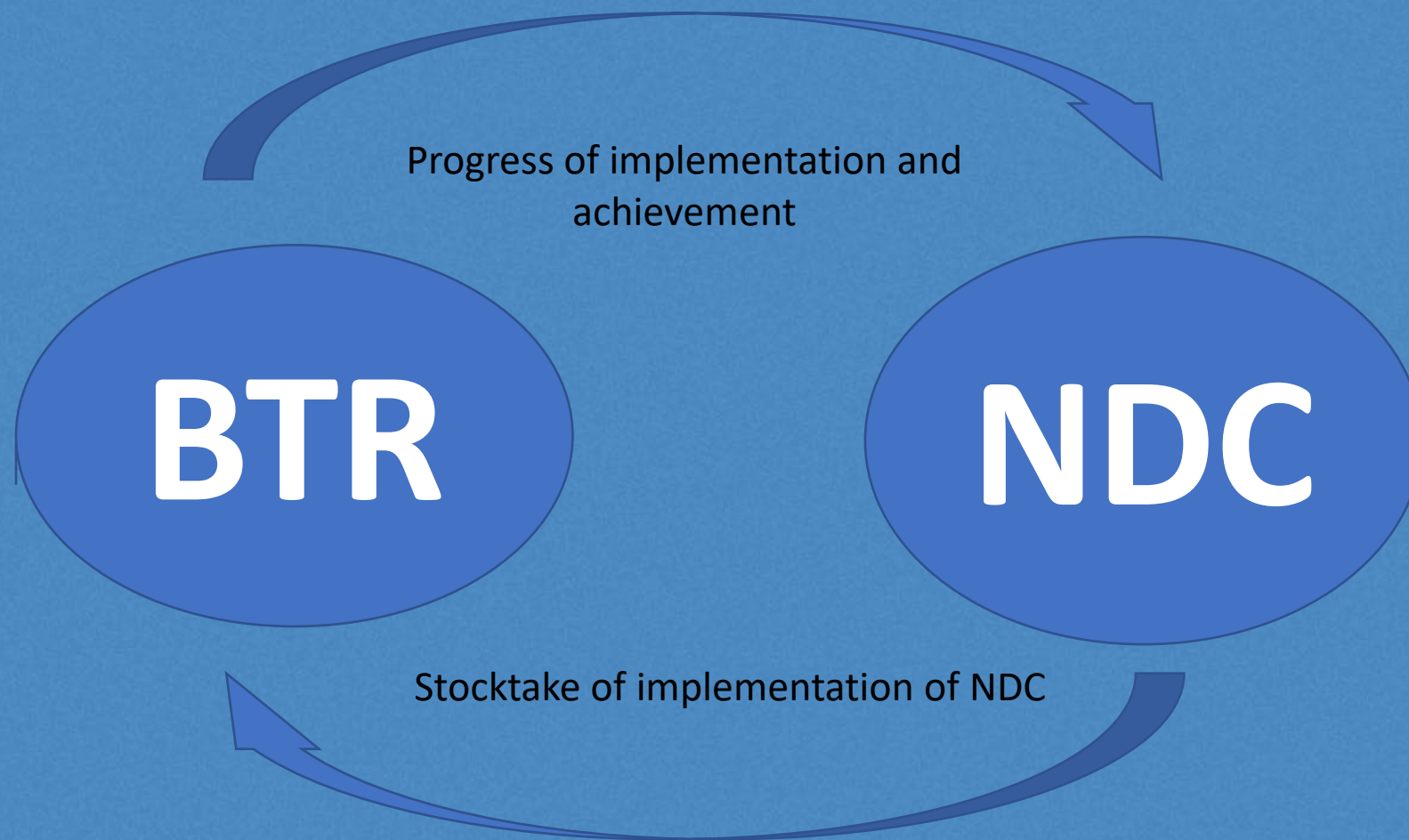
