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Biennial Transparency Reports (BTRs) are the backbone of climate reporting under the Paris Agreement

- The deadline for submission of the first BTRs is no later than December 31, 2024.
- Very limited time for the preparation and development of the report
- What should Parties be doing?
 - Gather information about the current situation (data, information) in the country
 - Identify an action plan to improve institutional arrangements
 - Develop a roadmap to understand and plan the necessary actions
 - Prioritize, use "flexibility" mechanisms in reporting, request support for capacity building!

Objective: To support countries in preparing their first BTRs





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

- Each substep ends with a series of considerations, recommended actions, and a list of relevant resources.

If your result suggests that you would not be meeting the deadline for the first BTR (31.12.2024), do not get discouraged Consider focusing only on the mandatory elements at first to be able to present at least those in your first -timely- submission and plan for improvements over time that will allow you to report on additional elements in your next BTR. Roadmap Example 1

1 No Parallel Processes:

not enough staff to carry out compilation activities simultaneously



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


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Roadmap Example No. 2

Responsibilities and tasks distributed among a team. Different tasks can be carried out simultaneously.

Some reporting tasks (e.g., GHG inventory and adaptation, will be carried out in parallel)

Still not on time! In this case, mainly due to the reporting of projections, as well as intensive training on training and capacity building




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Example of Roadmap No. 3

- Application of flexibility where needed (e.g. projections, impacts of mitigation measures, etc.)
- Re-assess the reporting of non-mandatory elements in the BTR (support, adaptation, REDD+ annex) or if it is better to do it somewhere else (e.g. Adaptation communication, which does not have the 2024 deadline).
- User can also challenge the time assumptions and customize the specific times of capacity building and compilation (if countries know for sure that they will receive support and will be able to complete a section of the report faster)

Goals and objectives of the approach

Use the existing PATPA/FAO tool and develop an "improved" version of the roadmap for the preparation of the first BTRs for the countries of the Anglophone Caribbean Network

This approach is used by **CBIT-GSP** to help countries to:


- Facilitate the reporting process and its qualitative improvement over time
- Understand the status of reporting, identify gaps in data, technical capacity and institutional arrangements that are required for the regular preparation of BTRs
- Plan and identify support needs from transparency partners
- Improve technical and institutional capacity and understand the roles of national team members
- Assist in the planning of subsequent BTRs and other reports within the framework of transparency





Scope of the Activity

- To carry out this activity, technical experts will support the country in the management of five steps necessary for the generation of the roadmap for 1BTR
- The duration of the exercise depends on the interest of the country and the national context and the capacity of the experts. Therefore, the dates will be agreed with the team during the preparatory coordination meeting.

Workshop Key Takeaways

1. BTR1 Submission

• Grenada intends to submit its BTR1 by April 2025.

2. Alignment with International Processes

Aligning all national processes (BTR, MRV System, NDC 3.0 Update) with international processes (GST) is crucial.

3. NDC Tracking Indicators

- Grenada has proposed NDC tracking indicators in the NDC Indicator Report (to be shared).
- The country will need to agree on the indicators used for the purpose of its BTR/CRTs.

4. Utilization of Flexibilities

- Country is encouraged to utilize all flexibilities to the extent possible.
- 5. Continuous Improvement
 - Do not wait until you have the perfect system; improve over time.
- 6. GHG Inventories
 - Grenada is in the process of assessing its GHG Inventory.
 - Instructional arrangements: internalize or use consultants with a role to up-train the government coordination team?
- 7. Chapter Leads for BTR
 - Grenada wants to set chapter leads for the BTR to be identified by the Friday session.
