What

- ✓ In narrative form or via the common tabular formats (CTF) include reference to all indicators relating to gender in mitigation PAMs using specific key words 'gender', 'men', 'women', 'boys' or 'girls'.
- ✓ In the absence of quantitative and qualitative gender indicators, identify the temporary measure, incentives, or anti-discrimination directives aimed at advancing gender equality in mitigation actions which can be tracked and reported.

Why

- Targets and indicator(s) are essential for tracking progress on Parties respective obligations on human rights, [...] gender equality and the empowerment of women and gender aims as defined in NDCs.

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Info necessary to track NDC progress



How

STEP 1. Report on prevalence of gender analysis and risk assessments (*i.e., none, limited, extensive*) and summarise key positive and negative findings

STEP 2. Work with national CCGFP and sectoral WGs to advocate for developing gender targets and indicators in mitigation measures

Time and resource investment

Categories of indicators

Example indicators

STEP 3. List developing gender targets and indicators for mitigation measures in the 'Improvement in reporting over time'; OR set gender targets and indicators

STEP 4. Until gender is integrated into MRV systems, request project managers update the BTR compilation team on progress against gender circumstances and highlight issues

Build capacity of women in water management

Number of **women trained** in plumbing, water plant treatments, and other water services

Number of women **entrepreneurs** in the water sector
