Challenges

- Organization and planning all review activities (before, during, after review week)
- Preparation of presentations / Discussion with TERT
- Use of UNFCCC communication tools for QRs: iVTR and VTR (online)
- Mobilization of all experts (external experts and stakeholders)
- Language used: Working language is English, Technical (Jargon)
- Good understanding of the review process and benefits for future reports (QA-QC)

Some good practices to prepare TER

- Conduct QA (UNFCCC QA: GHG support Unit),
- Review simulation (national experts),
- Retreat of all national experts and stakeholders (involved in the process),
- Provide additional material: calculation sheets, documents, tools, DB,...
- Interaction with reviewers (transparent, confidentiality)

Advice to MENA experts to become TER

- Voluntary process (financial support for travel and expenses DSA),
- Very Useful (enhance technical capacities, learning process, networking,...)
- Know-how transfer (tools, knowledge) to share with national experts,
- Contribute to the national process to prepare: BTR, NIR, NC (QA-QC)
