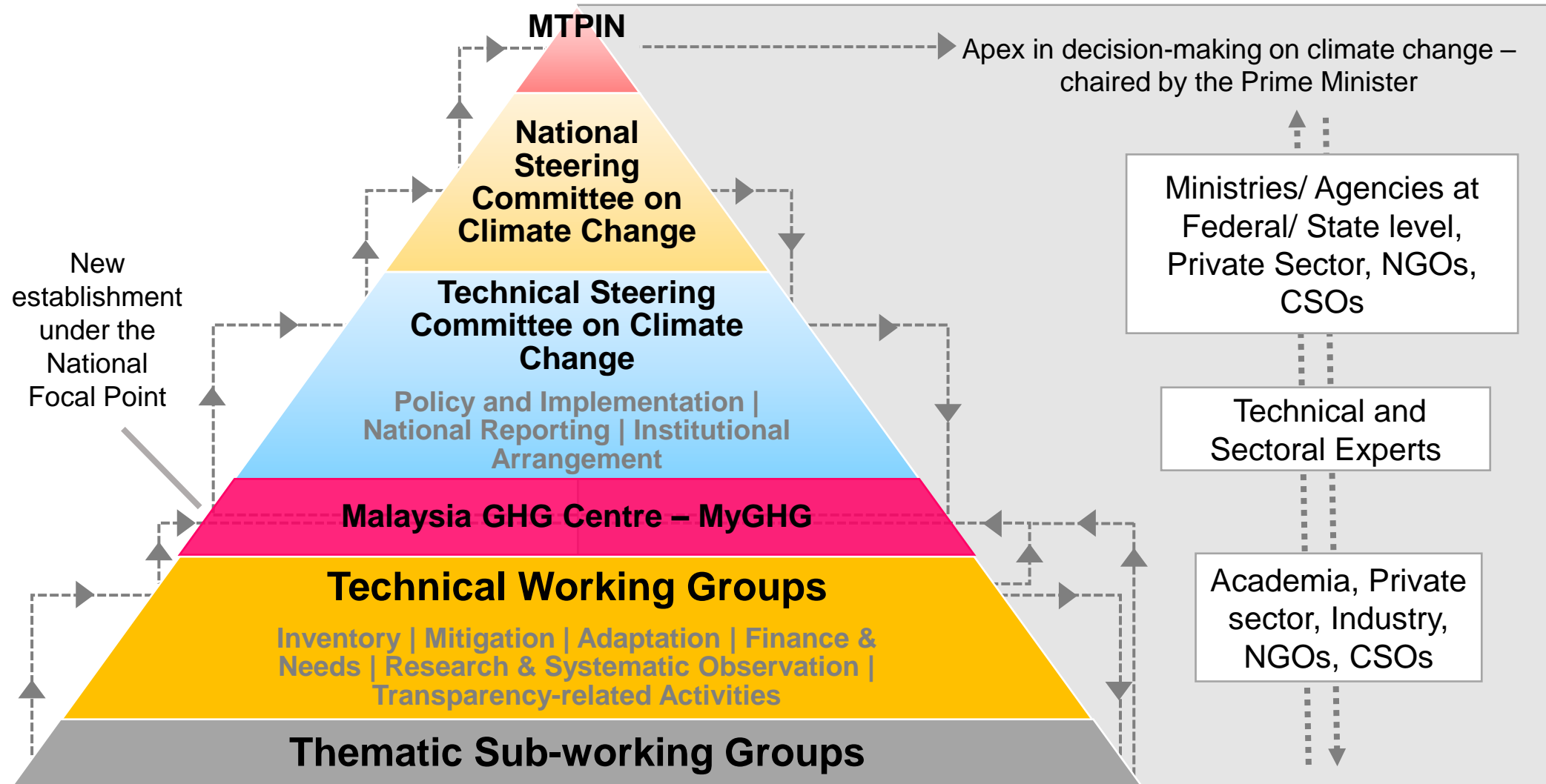

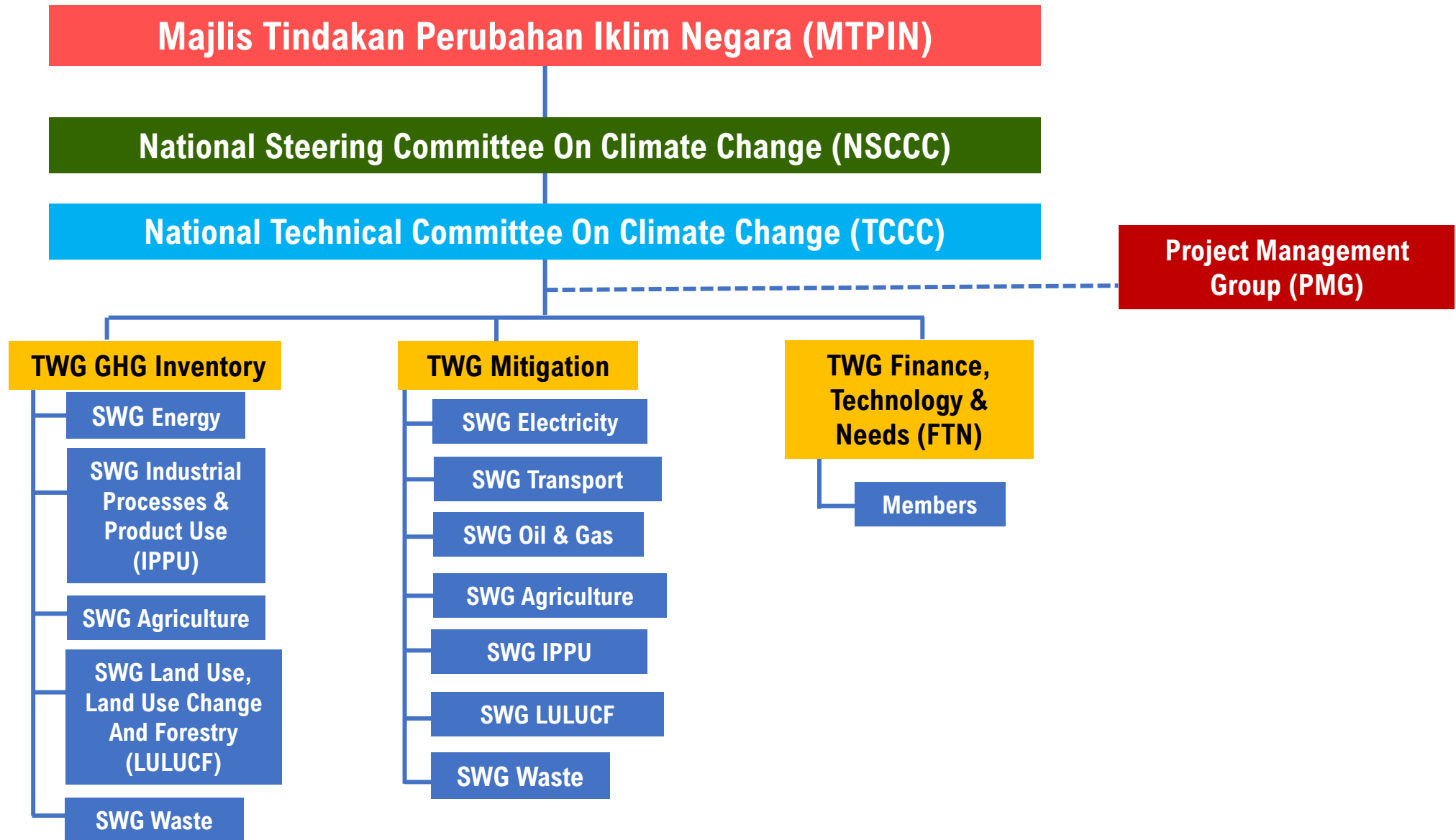

(NON-EXHASUTIVE) CHALLENGES

- *“This the first time to prepare the BTR1. Are we sure this can be delivered?”*
- *“Some of the officers are relatively new. Could the BTR1 be prepared with this condition?”*
- The kick-off was *later* given certain processes pertaining to the fund would take time to be channelled. The kick-off was made in May 2024 i.e. ~6-8 months towards submission deadline
- Relative capacity to prepare the BTR1

SOME POINTS

- De facto preparation started in Q3/Q4 2023, although the fund was only received in May 2024
- Gradual build up on the CMA's understanding starting in Q3/Q4 2023; monthly TWG meeting to refine / discuss the arising matters
- Capacity continuity from previous reporting exercise
- Continuous capacity building for new and current officers
- Flexibility / agility in context of project management
- Capacity enhancement on utilising IPCC Software for the purpose of CRT
