- There are a number of ways to administer GHG inventory arrangements as listed below:
- ☐ Centralized versus decentralised approach

Centralised Decentralised

A lead agency or department or team may maintain control and decision making authority on the inventory preparation process. This approach may include other institutions Many different teams, agencies and institutions that each work on different aspects of the GHG inventory and make their own decisions with regards to methodologies and estimation

In-sourced versus Out-sourced

In-sourced

Most of the Inventory is prepared by employees within departments of an existing organisation

Out-sourced

The work is completed by private consultants, research institutions, academic organisations or nongovernmental organisations

> Single versus Multi-Agency

Single Agency

The lead body may be housed in a single department

Multi-Agency

The lead body may be made up of a multi-agency working group or committe

> Integrated versus separate

Integrated

The GHG inventory work may be integrated with on other pollutant inventories e.g., air quality or toxic pollutants an other environmental reporting efforts

Separate

The GHG inventory team is separate from other inventories and reporting efforts.
