Shift in Project Timeline

• Always consider a change in the project timeline.

Project activities delay

• This might result from technical issues. Late signing of project agreement.

Limited financial budget

• This can cause difficulties in the project delivery.

Data gaps

• There are gaps, missing and no updated data.

Communication breakdown

• There can be misunderstandings & miscommunication between the project & stakeho

Stakeholder engagement

• Expect a lack of stakeholders' engagement and data provision.

Change in Government

• This can change government priorities & processes
