
The BTR Imperative: Why Data Harmonization Matters More Than Ever



Peer Learning Cycle for Climate Action





BTR Implementation: Key Actionable Takeaways



Immediate Actions

- Establish robust governance structures with clear roles, accountability, and multi-stakeholder engagement
- Implement systematic data quality frameworks with standardized formats and integrated management systems

Medium-Term Development

- **Build technical expertise** through training programs and communities of practice
- **Develop sustainability strategies** by embedding BTR processes in regular government operations

Success Factors

- ✓ Formalize arrangements through legal instruments
- √ Leverage existing datasets and SDG monitoring synergies.
- ✓ Utilize CBIT support mechanisms
- ✓ Document experiences for continuous improvement
