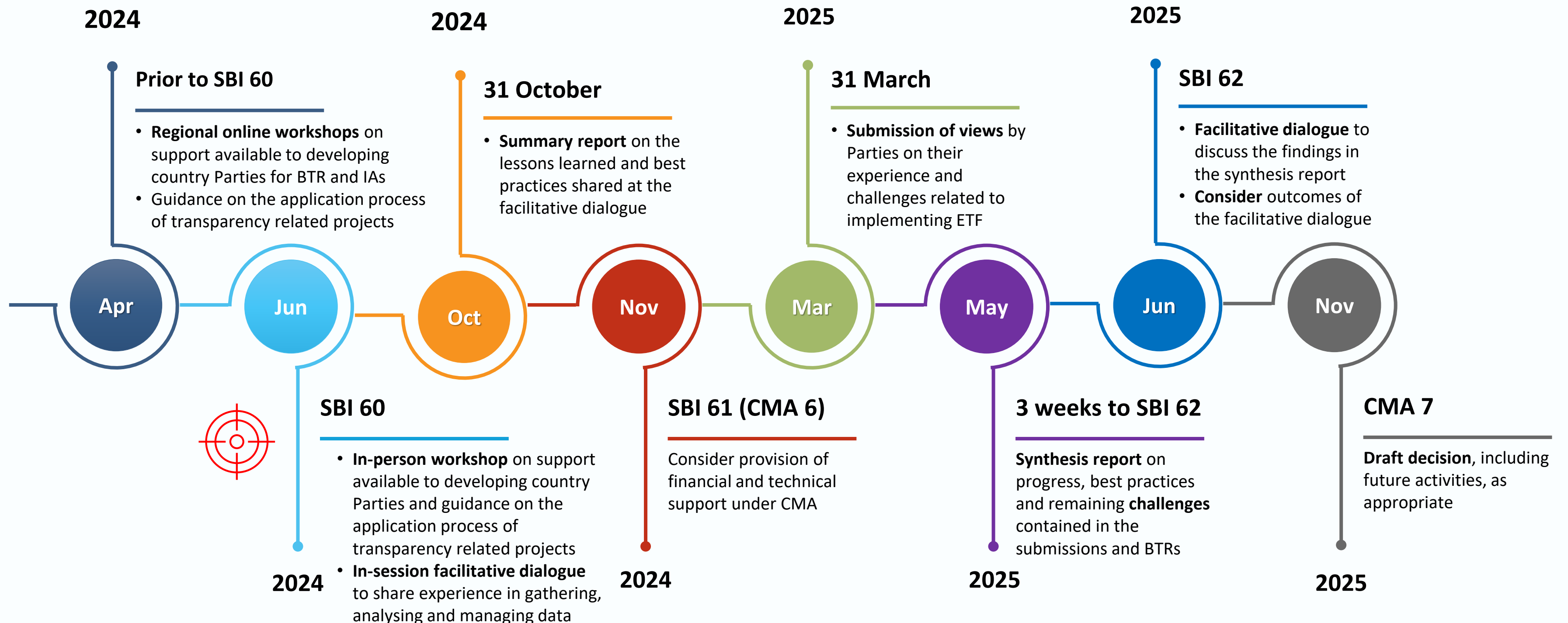

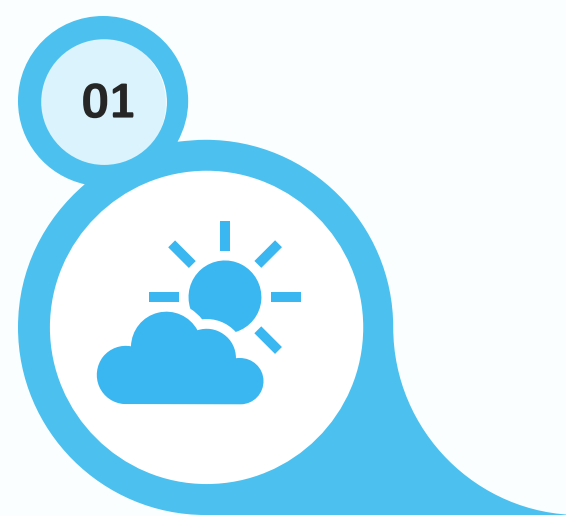
Key highlights from COP28

- Signalling the “beginning of the end” for the fossil fuel era
- New funding for loss and damage (USD 600 million plus)
- Enhancing global efforts to strengthen resilience (targets for the GGA and its framework in place now)
- Linking climate action with nature conservation (halting and reversing deforestation and forest degradation by 2030)
- Ramping up practical climate solutions
- Looking ahead – finance and transparency
 - **Transparency - BTRs in 2024; NDCs (ICTU) covering all GHGs in 2025**

Dubai outcome on provision of financial and technical support for ETF

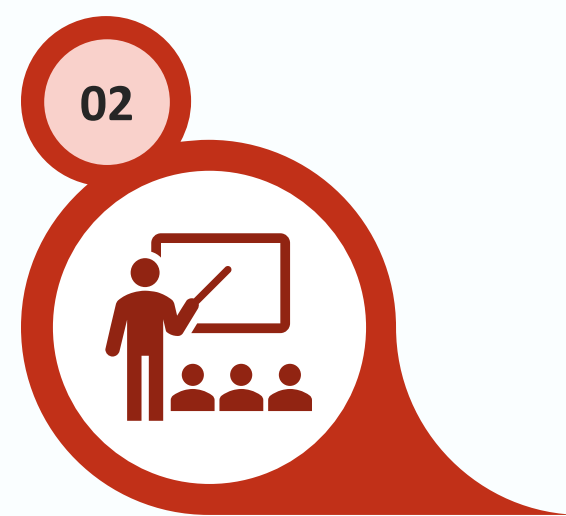


Dubai outcome on provision of financial and technical support for ETF

Facilitate regional cooperation for promoting exchange of experience, lessons learned and best practices and networking among Parties

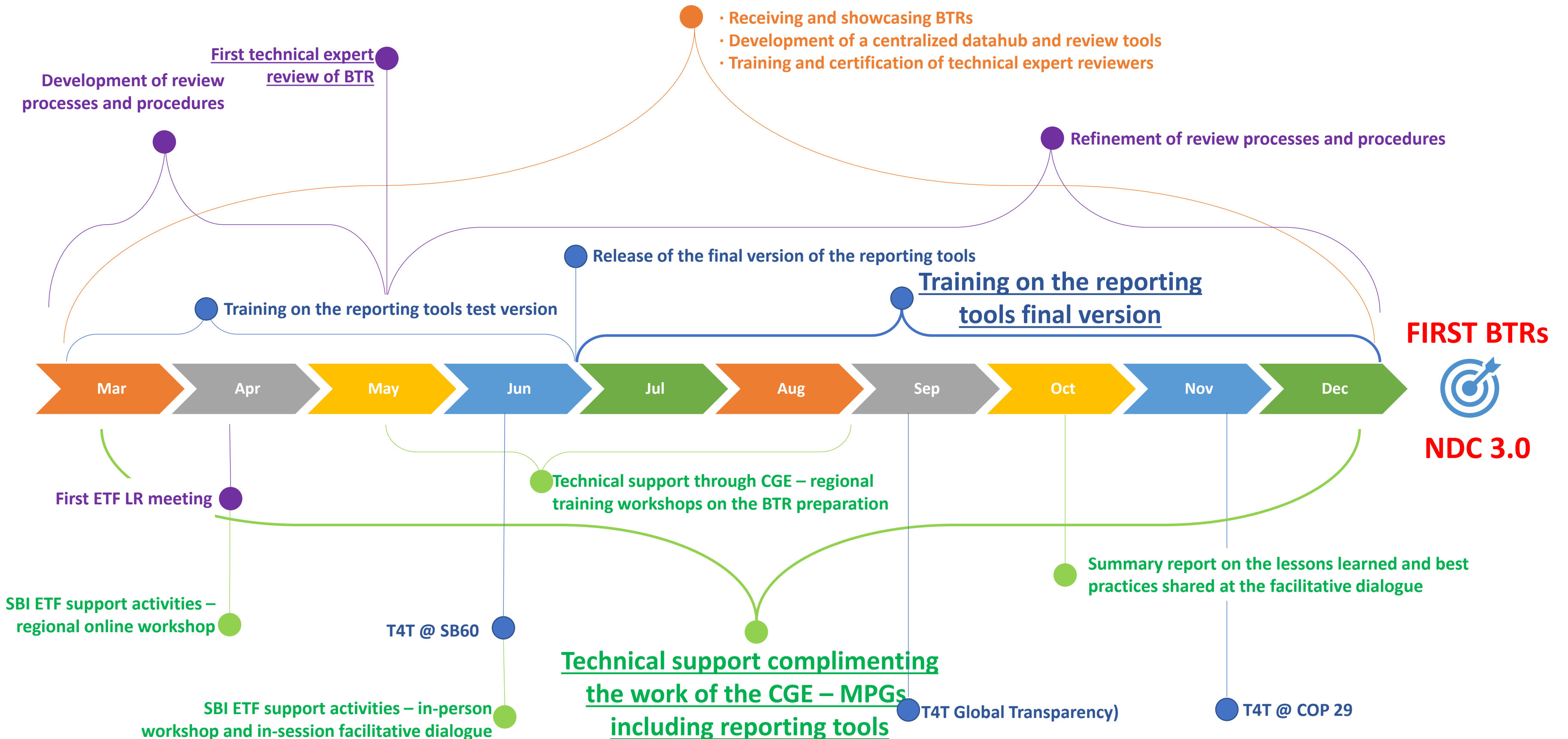


Coordination
