
- Survey conducted during 04 20 March 2019

## What were the benefits that you have gained from this network?










## How often do you visit/use the collaboration platform?



### Experiences around using the collaboration platform

#### Usefulness

- Easy tool to keep everyone updated of who is who and who is doing what, beyond face-to-face meetings;
- Easy access to documents and calendar of activities;
- Easy to search support activities by others in certain countries, which informs the design of activities building on what has already been done;
- Updates and reminders via email are important to maintain engagement;

### Challenges


- Unclear instruction from the site when the attempted use was unsuccessful;
- Difficulty in using UNFCCC external user account;
- Impacts in daily work (i.e. coordination to reduce duplication) are limited.

### Potential constraints and suggestions to enhance the working practice

#### Constraints

- Lack of available time to share in this type of collaborative initiatives;
- Challenges in fitting with planning processes of different organizations;
- As UNFCCC-related work streams continue to grow, covering them all through a single space might become challenging;

### Suggestions


- Discussion has to be country-specific. It would be good to have an overview of who is active in what country so that a targeted exchange can be arranged;
- Face-to-face meeting is important, but more important is to have the platform active and alive by <u>all participants</u>:
  - → Nominate steady focal points to encourage all members' participation;
  - → Send a monthly reminder with a quick recap of new activities;
- Need to engage in substantive discussion for collaboration (to go beyond understanding of who is doing what).
