### **Objectives and methodology**

### • Objective:

• To assess the transparency systems and related capacity needs of the countries of the Pacific region to comply with the reporting requirements of the UNFCCC and the Paris Agreement.

### Methodology and approach:

- Online questionnaire, referential check and desk-top study and meetings with the country focal points
- (i) GHG Inventory; (ii) NDC tracking; (iii) Adaptation and Impacts, incl. loss and damage issues; (iv) Support needed and received.
- 14 countries in the Pacific Region (92% responded) of the regional network: Cook Islands, Kiribati, Fiji, Marshall Islands, Micronesia, Nauru, Niue, Palau, Papua New Guinea, Samoa, Solomon Islands, Tonga, Tuvalu and Vanuatu.




## Transparency System in the Pacific








## Implementing ETF and preparation for the BTR

Funding approved: Fiji, Kiribati, Solomon Islands, Vanuatu, Cook Islands









# Capacity assessment related to four ETF reporting areas

## **Institutional Arrangements on ETF Reporting Areas**



- Limited capacity to set-up a robust institutional arrangement
- · Lack of legal mandates to share information
- Minimum buy-in and support from stakeholders to provide data and information

## Technical Capacities to collect data/track progress on ETF Reporting areas




- Frequent turnover of the national specialists within governmental institutions
- · Lack of data and information
- Limited training opportunities on transparency









## **Assessment of capacities in GHG Inventory**







## Domestic systems to monitor adaptation actions



### **NAP Status in the Pacific**



## Key take-away messages of the capacity assessment

- All countries need more capacity building exercises understand the requirements of the ETF and reporting of BTR.
- Insufficient institutional arrangements is a main challenge in the region.
- GHG Inventory is highly prioritized by most countries
- NDC tracking require capacity building especially in determining indicators for tracking and projections/modeling
- Adaptation and Impacts Monitoring the adaptation actions is vital.
- Reporting on Loss and Damage There is only one country that has started assessing losses and damages

## **Priority areas for support**

#### All countries highlighted the need for capacity and support in the following areas:

- Transition to the ETF: Development and preparation of BTRs.
- **GHG inventory**: institutional arrangements, QA/QC, best practices on software-based estimations, new IPCC methodologies, tools, data collection and management process
- **Setting up an effective institutional arrangement:** MoUs and legal arrangements for establishing transparency systems; assigning the roles and tasks of various stakeholders.
- Effective models for GHG projections: best practices from other countries.
- **NDC Tracking:** target setting, determining the indicators for tracking progress and climate reporting under the NDC relevant section in the BTR.
- Climate finance: tools and mechanisms in tracking support received/needed; development of climate finance tracking systems.
- Adaptation and Impacts: assessing the effectiveness of the adaptation measures and determination of quantitative/qualitative indicators.
- Loss and damage: methodologies, tools and approaches in assessing and estimation of L&D.
