Duration: April 2022 to 2026.

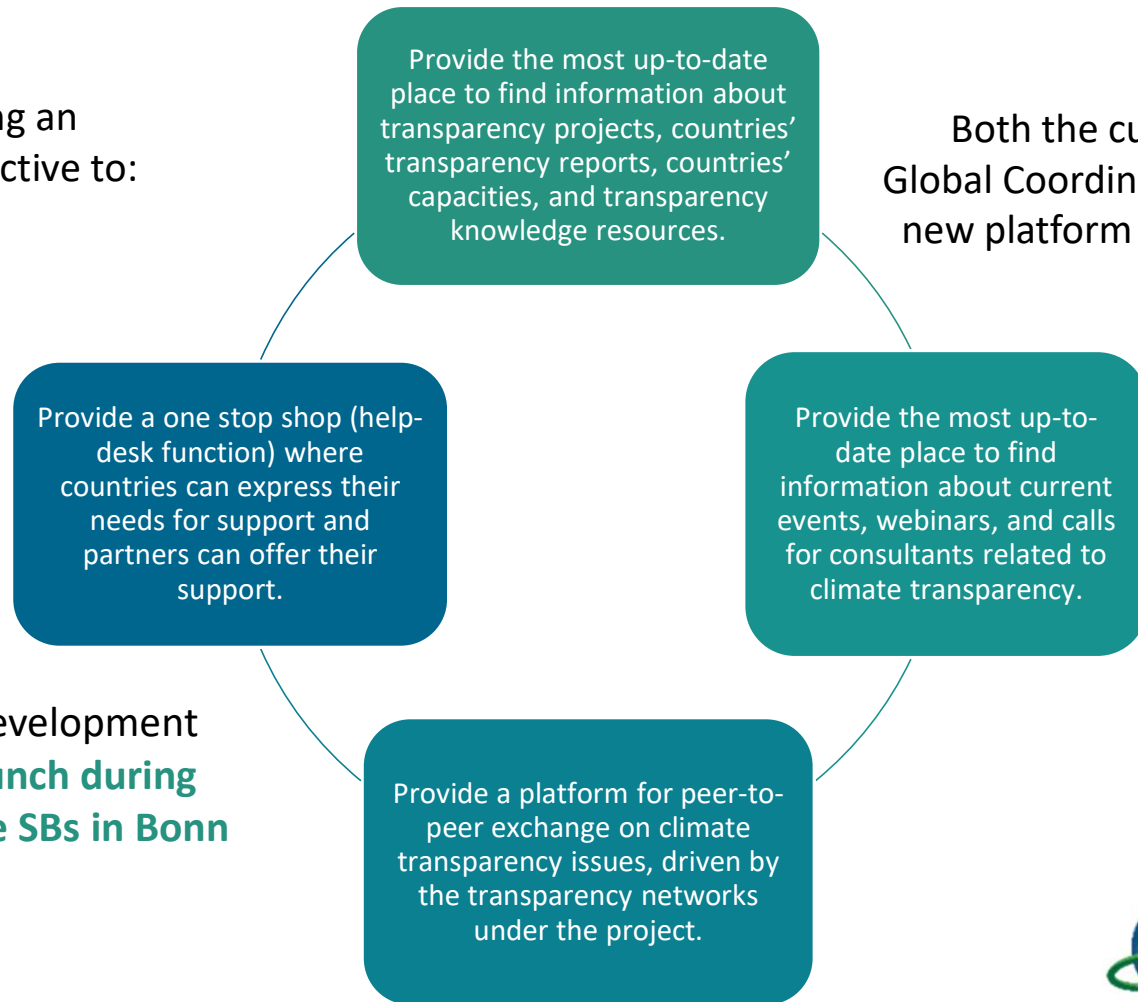
