- III. Sharing knowledge and lessons learned with other countries and transparency practitioners

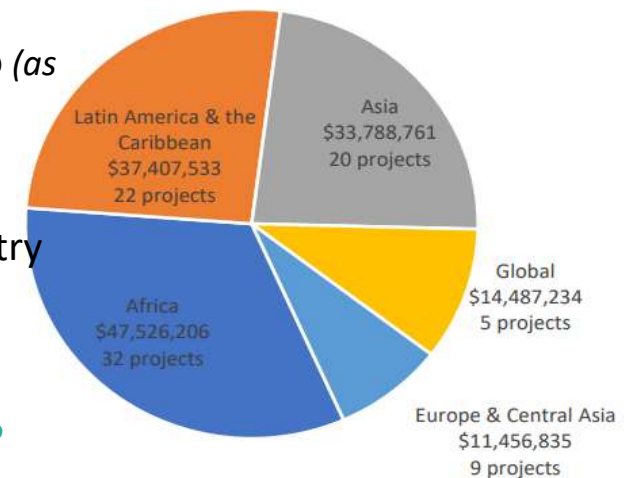
Capacity-building Initiative for Transparency (CBIT)

- Established through decision at COP 21, administered by GEF
- Supports developing country Parties in meeting enhanced transparency requirements as defined in Article 13 of the Agreement in a timely manner (upon request)

CBIT Project Portfolio (as of Oct 31, 2022)

88 projects in 86 countries:

- 82 individual country projects
- 1 regional project
- 5 global projects, including CBIT-GSP

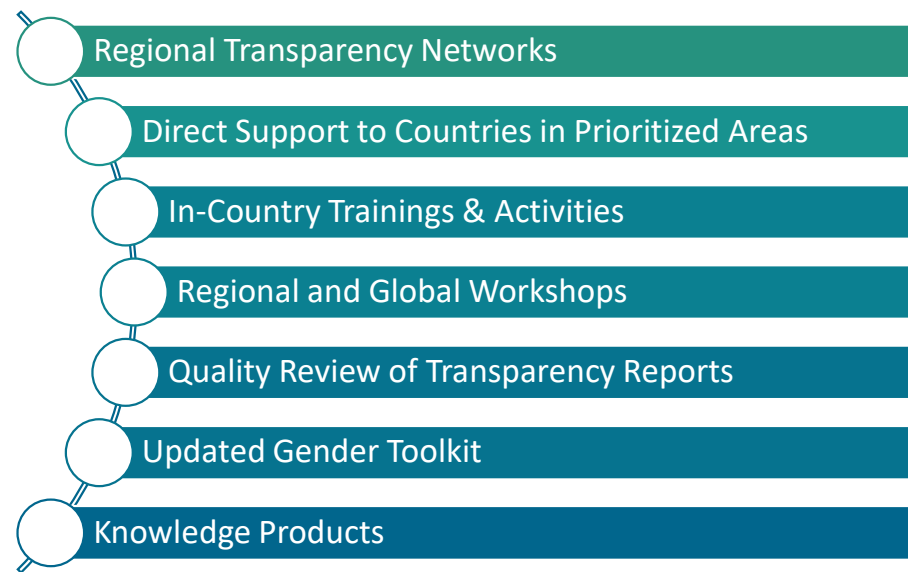


Capacity-building Initiative for Transparency - Global Support Programme (CBIT-GSP)

- Duration: April 2022 – end of 2026, Budget: ~ 9 Million USD

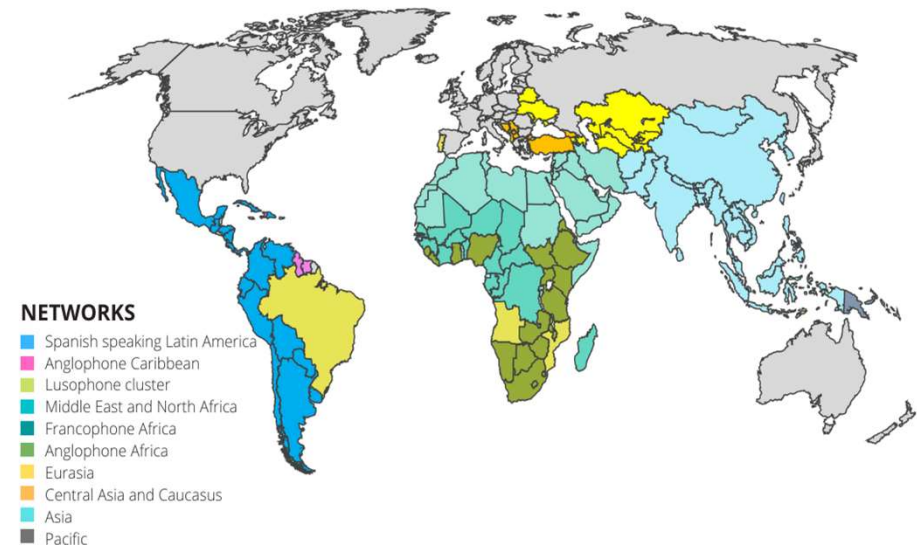
Main Mediums of Support

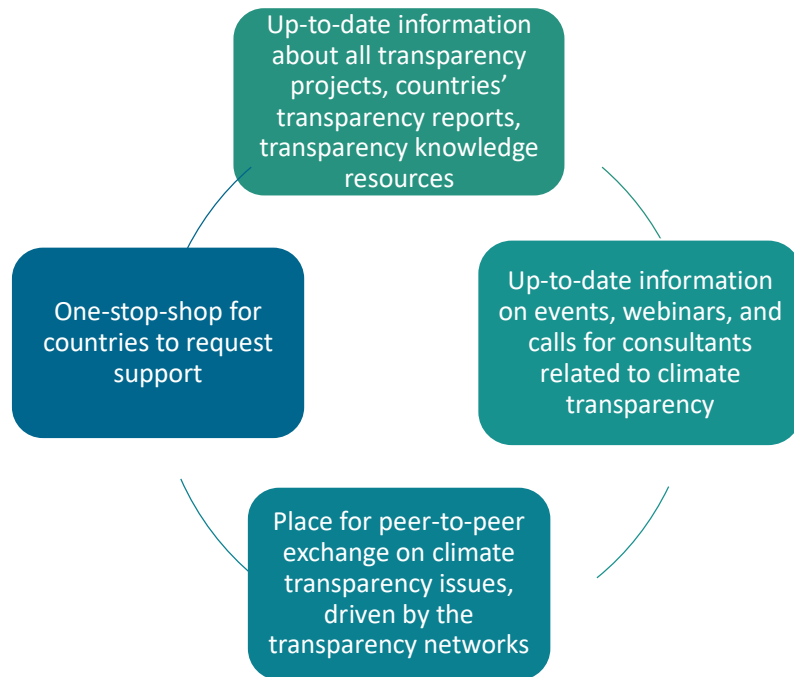
- **Support the transition to the BTRs**
