Background

Article 13 of the Paris Agreement established an Enhanced Transparency Framework (ETF) for action and support that takes into account Parties' different capacities and builds upon collective experience. The first reports under the enhanced transparency framework will be submitted by Parties by no later than 31 December 2024.

Objectives

This online event is a collaborative effort by the FAO, PATPA, and UNFCCC and aims to:

- Learn from countries where they stand in preparing for the submission of their Biennial Transparency Report (BTR) in 2024
- Facilitate exchanges among country experts on the main needs and challenges in the preparation of BTRs, the initial steps to be taken, as well as lessons learned and best practices
- Introduce the 'BTR Guidance and Roadmap Tool' that could be tailored to countries' specific situation and guide them to set their timeline for the preparation of BTR as well as a roadmap for the implementation
